HIGHLAND CAVALIERS LOOK FOR SECOND UPSET OF HIGHLY RANKED OPPONENT

UVa-Wise will look for a second upset of a highly ranked opponent in as many weeks on Saturday afternoon. This week's opponent will be top five ranked Bethel College in another one of the marquee matchups of the weekend in NAIA football. The contest will have both the Highland Cavaliers and the Wildcats rated in the nation's top 10 of both the NAIA and Victory Sports Network polls this week.

Even with the closeness of the rankings, the Cavs will go into the weekend as underdogs to the Wildcats with the game being played at the one year old Wildcat Stadium with a 2:30 p.m. eastern kick-off.

FIRST MEETING IN THREE YEARS

Saturday will be the 7th meeting in the last 15 seasons between the two schools separated by 460 miles. The two teams meet for the first time in three year and have played the first six games very close by splitting them three wins apiece.

Bethel claimed the last two contests of the meetings back in the 2003 (41-37) and 2004 (47-39) seasons. UVa-Wise took three of the first four games from 1993 through 1996.

The total points are slightly in the Cavs favor 238-205. Five of the previous six games have seen the winner score at least 41 points with a potential of another high-scoring affair set for the 2007 version.

UVa-Wise is 2-1 at Bethel with victories in McKenzie back in 1993 and 1995. The visiting team is actually 4-2 in the series.

CAVS AIM FOR FOURTH 5-0 START IN PROGRAM HISTORY

The 2007 Highland Cavaliers will try to join only three other previous teams of the 17 overall this weekend. UVa-Wise has started a season 5-0 three times since the program started in the fall of 1991.

The last time the Cavs reached the five wins to begin a season came 11 years ago in 1996 as part of three-straight years to open with as many wins. The 1996 squad produced the longest win streak in school history by going 10-0 for the regular season before falling in the NAIA playoff first round. In 1995, the Cavs started with victories in the opening eight contests after winning the first six games the previous year in the fall of 1994.

COACHING MATCHUP

The week's head coaching matchup will be the first Mid-South crossover contest of the year for both Bethel's Dino Kaklis and Bruce Wasem for the Cavs.

In his sixth-year as head coach of the Wildcats, Kaklis led Bethel to an impressive 10-3 mark last year and run into the NAIA. The Wildcats have a 30-27 mark under Kaklis.

Coach Wasem is now in his sixth year as the head coach of the Cavs. He has been part of all 177 games in the Highland Cavaliers aftering being an assistant coach in the program's first 11 campaigns under his mentor Bill Ramseyer. The Cavs are 25-33 during his tenure.

CAVS OPPONENT LAST WEEK/LAST GAME

BETHEL (W, 49-20 at Jackson, Miss.)

The Wildcats outscored the Blazers, 28-6, in the first half and were never challenged last week. Bethel totaled 14 points in each of the first three quarters including two kick-off returns for touchdowns of 85 and 76 yards along with grabbing another score as part of his three catches. Adrain Smith and Terrence Bell combined for 175 rushing yards on 27 carries and three scores while cornerback Donald Lightfoot picked off two passes.

HIPPEARD TO BECOME CAVS' 2ND 6,000-YD PASSER

Junior quarterback Randy Hippeard is set to become just the second passer in the 17th-year history of the program to eclipse the 6,000-yard mark at Bethel College.

Hippeard heads into the weekend with 5,954 yards in 23 career games to put him just 46 yards away from 6,000, behind only David Nara (1991-94) with 6,517 yards. He is averaging 258.9 yards per game passing leading the Cavs' offense.

He already has the career touchdowns mark of 50 while only throwing 23 interceptions.

Hippeard needs 38 completions to capture that record as well as he has 397 while Nara has 435.

THE BROTHERS' FIVE IN THE FAMILY OF CAVS

The UVa-Wise football is just one of two collegiate football teams to have five sets of brothers on the squad. The squad is joined by only NCAA D1-AA Montana with that many sets of siblings. UVa-Wise has eight of its 10 brothers see regular action while according to Montana just four of its 10 is seeing regular action this season.

The five sets of brothers are: 77-Henry Potter & 3-Jahmal Potter; 55-Aaron Mathis & 41-John Mathis; 42-Keon White & 44-Kevin White; 9-Keith McBride & 33-Travis McBride and 57-Luke Spurlock & 59-Josh Spurlock.

Week 1

UVA-Wise 41, Brevard 23

WISE, Va. -- All-American UVA-Wise running back Ra'Shad Morgan picked up where he left off a year ago by plowing through the Brevard College defense for 243 yards and four touchdowns in a season opening 41-23 victory.

Leading 34-23, Morgan sealed the win by breaking three Tornados' tacklers on his way to a 50-yard touchdown with 3:16 to cap his outstanding evening.

Morgan ran for his 243 yards, the third most in Cavs' history, on 29 carries for an 8.4-yard average with four scores. The senior running back set the school mark with 289 yards a year ago against Cumberland University.

QB Randy Hippeard hit 16 of 24 attempts for 218 yards and 2 TDs. Matt Barbour had his best day of his career with six catches for 110 yards and a 44-yard score. Jason Lovett had a solid day with five receptions for 72 yards and a 30-yard TD in his first game at wideout.

MLB Ben Robertson produced 15 tackles and a tackle for loss. Chas Johnson added 11 stops while Keith McBride and Jahmal Potter snatched interceptions.

The Tornados took its opening possession 51 yards on 14 plays for the opening score. Morgan went to work shortly afterwards by scoring three times over the final 15:40 of the first half from 16, four and one yard for a 21-14 halftime tally.

Hippeard hit Lovett on the first possession of the second half from 30 yards and early in the fourth connected from 44 yards with Barbour for a 34-23 score. The score remained 34-23 until Morgan's tough 50-yard burst through Brevard defenders for the 41-23 final.

Week 2

UVA-Wise 61, North Greenville 55

TIGERVILLE, SC -- QB Randy Hippeard directed what has to be the wildest comeback and game in the 17-year history of UVA-Wise football history. Hippeard helped the Cavs score 41 second half points, erase a 14-point deficit and score two touchdowns in the final 1:11 of the game for a 61-55 victory.

Trailing 55-48 with 2:42 left in the game, Hippeard went four for four, all to Jason Lovett, for 60 of the drives 72 yards to pull to within 55-54. The quarterback two-point conversion pass was intercepted by North Greenville's Donovan Davis at the goal line.

Cavs' Nate Bryant kicked an on-sides kick through the right two lines of the Crusaders' hands team and wide out Aric Evans fell on the ball for the visitors. UVA-Wise took over at its own 46-yard line. Hippeard hit Brad Ricker for passes of 21 and five yards and then Matt Barbour for 25 yards to the home three-yard line. The ball was handed off to All-American running back Ra'Shad Morgan who scampered through the left side for the final three yards to take it to 61-55 with 22 seconds.

North Greenville completed a 21-yard pass to the UVA-Wise 30-yard line before its next pass took the rest of the time off the clock to end the game.

Hippeard set three school single game records with 32 completions, 564 yards passing and six touchdowns through the air. The junior connected on 20 of 26 passes in the deciding second half for 358 yards. He had three targets set career-best marks on the night. Evans grabbed six passes for 212 yards and three scores, Barbour pulled in 10 passes for 179 yards and one TD and Lovett had nine catches for 122 yards and two scores.

UVA-Wise 35, Concord 28

ATHENS, WV -- UVA-Wise picked off four passes and found a way to score the game winning points in the final two minutes to defeat Concord University, 35-28.

Tied 28-28 with 3:45 left in the game, RB Ra'Shad Morgan and QB Randy Hippeard combined for the game-winning drive. Morgan ran for two yards before Hippeard threw an incomplection and followed with back-to-back 17-yard passes to Jason Lovett and Matt Barbour to the home 24-yardline. Morgan worked his way through the Concord defense for 17 yards before following with a seven-yard scoring run over the left side to lead 35-28 with 2:05 in the game.

On 4th-and- 19 from its 41-yardline, LB Chas Johnson picked off the 4th Cavs' INT to seal the win.

DE Reggie Dorsainvil and the LB duo of Chad Hooker and Ben Robertson paced the defensive. Dorsainvil posted 11 tackles, two tfl's, 1.5 sacks and an INT. Hooker had a career-high 14 stops and Robertson added 11 tackles. Josh Spurlock and Marvin White also had Int's.

Morgan ran 110 yards on 24 carries with a TD and caught 6 passes for 56 yards including a 19-yard TD. Hippeard passed for 237 yards and 3 TDs including a 60-yd TD-strike to Aric Evans.

Week 4

UVA-Wise 63, Georgetown 56

WISE, Va. -- In front of a packed Carl Smith Stadium of well over 8,000 in attendance, the 10th-ranked UVA-Wise recorded its biggest Homecoming victory in program history over the seventh-ranked Georgetown College 63-56.

For the third-straight contest, Ra'Shad Morgan capped the game-winning drive with a touchdown run as the Cavs scored last to post the high-scoring upset.

The win is the first in eight games over the past eight years in the Mid-South Conference series between the two gridiron clubs and the highest ranked opponent UVA-Wise has ever defeated.

WR Jason Lovett produced his best game of his young career. He pulled in four passes for 181 yards and two touchdowns while he threw for another score covering 45 yards. QB Randy Hippeard hit 16 of 35 attempts for 387 yards and 3 TDs. Morgan ran for just 68 yards on 28 attempts but did score four times including the game-winner.

LB Ben Robertson paced the Cavs defense with 10 tackles, a sack, 1.5 tfls and an INT. James Haley contributed 9 stops, FF and 2BK while Chas Johnson added 9 TT, SK, and a tfl. Bryan Tolbert picked off one pass and battled down two more to go with 6 tackles while Josh Spurlock snatched his 2nd pick in 2 games. Jerry Bentley had the other Cavs' sack. Brandon Moore returned a kick-off 88 yards for a TD and had 5 tackles on defense.

After Hippeard was intercepted, Georgetown drove 23 yards on four plays capped by a four-yard Brown run to tie the game, 56-56, with 2:14 left in the game.
