### HIGHLAND CAVALIERS TRY TO EQUAL WIN TOTAL FROM A YEAR AGO AGAINST BULLDOGS

After successfully returning to Mid-South East Division action last weekend, UVA-Wise will not only seek to stay in the top spot but also equal its 2006 win total.

The Highland Cavaliers enter Saturday tied with the University of the Cumberlands for the lead of the Mid-South East with 2-0 records. The 17th-ranked Patriots host 19th-rated Georgetown College Tigers for a 1:30 p.m. start.

### CAVS AIM FOR EIGHTH WIN FOR SECOND YEAR

The Cavs aim for their eighth win of the year Saturday. UVA-Wise finished the 2006 campaign at 8-3 to snap a four-year drought of non-winning seasons. The program can equal the win total and tie last year's third most victories in a season in the 17th-year history. The 1995 and 1996 clubs both posted 10 wins.

### UVA-WISE GO FOR FIRST WIN IN BARBOURVILLE

For the four time, UVA-Wise will travel the just over 100 miles to Barbourville, Ky. The Cavs have not been able to come out on the winning side of the equation.

Union prevailed in the last game held on its field, 47-28, to end the 2005 season. The Bulldogs have posted at least 33 points in each of the their three wins at home.

The Cavs broke a two-game losing streak to finish the 2006 campaign by a 21-6 score in a rainy and windy afternoon.

In the series, the Bulldogs ran off wins in the both meetings in the last decade (1992 & 1993) while the Cavs are 2-3 in the 2000's.

The points scored in the six-game series heavily favor Union by a 241-150 total.

The Bears lead the total points scored, 200-150, in the series.

**UNION (L, 7-28 at Frostburg, Md.)**

NCAA Division III Frostburg State ran for 224 rushing yards to hand Union a 28-7 defeat.

Union's lone score came in the fourth quarter when Kyle Callahan hit Chris Callopy from 11 yards with 5:51 to play.

The Bobcats outgained the Bulldogs, 352-295, in total offense even with two fumbles. Union's Terence Pollock paced the attack with 101 yards on 17 carries for his second 100-yard outing.

Patrick O'Neal, the AAC's top tackler, had 10 stops.

## LAST MEETING IN BARBOURVILLE

Host Union scored the first 27 points off three touchdown passes from Joey Waters on the way to a 47-28 victory to end the 2005 season over UVa-Wise. The Cavs were able to get no closer than 12 points, 33-21 and 40-28, when Randy Hippeard threw touchdown passes of 11 and six yards to Kendon Doe, with the last coming with 1:21 left. Bulldog Dominic Yuille ran in a score from four yards less than a minute later with 36 seconds for the final.

RB Ra'Shad Morgan ran 12 times for 139 yards while Hippeard was just 14 of 30 for 147 yards with 2 TDs and an interception. Hakeem Abdul-Saboor caught five passes for 89 yards.

Waters completed 24 of 37 passes for 337 yards with four scores and an interception.

## RAINY 2006 FINALE

RB Ra'Shad Morgan ran for 191 yards on 33 carries and two touchdowns to take the Cavs over the Bulldogs, 21-6, in a rainy 2006 season finale. Morgan totaled 269 all-purpose yards with six catches for 78 yards as the top receiver.

QB Randy Hippeard was 13 of 32 for 189 yards with no TDs.

Kyle Callahan served as the Union QB with 189 yards passing with a 27-yard score, the Bulldogs' lone touchdown, on 11 of 35 attempts.

## Week 1

### UVA-Wise 41, Brevard 23

WISE, Va. -- All-American UVa-Wise running back Ra'Shad Morgan picked up where he left off a year ago by plowing through the Brevard College defense for 243 yards and four touchdowns in a season opening 41-23 victory.

Leading 34-23, Morgan sealed the win by breaking three Tornados' tacklers on his way to a 50-yard touchdown with 3:16 to cap his outstanding evening.

Morgan ran for his 243 yards, the third most in Cavs' history, on 29 carries for an 8.4-yard average with four scores. The senior running back set the school mark with 289 yards a year ago against Cumberland University.

QB Randy Hippeard hit 16 of 24 attempts for 218 yards and 2 TDs. Matt Barbour had his best day of his career with six catches for 110 yards and a 44-yard score. Jason Lovett had a solid day with five receptions for 72 yards and a 30-yard TD in his first game at wideout.

MLB Ben Robertson produced 15 tackles and a tackle for loss. Chas Johnson added 11 stops while Keith McBride and Jahmal Potter snatched interceptions.

The Tornados took its opening possession 51 yards on 14 plays for the opening score. Morgan went to work shortly afterwards by scoring three times over the final 15:40 of the first half from 16, four and one yard for a 21-14 halftime tally.

Hippeard hit Lovett on the first possession of the second half from 30 yards and early in the fourth connected from 44 yards with Barbour for a 34-23 score. The score remained 34-23 until Morgan's tough 50-yard burst through Brevard defenders for the 41-23 final.

## Week 2

### UVA-Wise 61, North Greenville 55

TIGERVILLE, SC -- QB Randy Hippeard directed what has to be the wildest comeback and game in the 17-year history of UVa-Wise football history. Hippeard helped the Cavs score 41 second half points, erase a 14-point deficit and score two touchdowns in the final 1:11 of the game for a 61-55 victory.

Trailing 55-48 with 2:42 left in the game, Hippeard went four for four, all to Jason Lovett, for 60 of the drives 72 yards to pull to within 55-54. The quarterback two-point conversion pass was intercepted by North Greenville's Donovan Davis at the goal line.

Cavs' Nate Bryant kicked an on-sides kick through the right two lines of the Crusaders' hands team and wide out Aric Evans fell on the ball for the visitors. UVa-Wise took over at its own 46-yard line. Hippeard hit Brad Ricker for passes of 21 and five yards and then Matt Barbour for 25 yards to the home three-yard line. The ball was handed off to All-American running back Ra'Shad Morgan who scampered through the left side for the final three yards to take it to 61-55 with 22 seconds.

North Greenville completed a 21-yard pass to the UVa-Wise 30-yard line before its next pass took the rest of the time off the clock to end the game.

Hippeard set three school single game records with 32 completions, 564 yards passing and six touchdowns through the air. The junior connected on 20 of 26 passes in the deciding second half for 358 yards. He had three targets set career-best marks on the night. Evans grabbed six passes for 212 yards and three scores, Barbour pulled in 10 passes for 179 yards and one TD and Lovett had nine catches for 122 yards and two scores.

## Week 3

### UVA-Wise 35, Concord 28

ATHENS, WV -- UVa-Wise picked off four passes and found a way to score the game winning points in the final two minutes to defeat Concord University, 35-28.

Tied 28-28 with 3:45 left in the game, RB Ra'Shad Morgan and QB Randy Hippeard combined for the game-winning drive. Morgan ran for two yards before Hippeard threw an incompletion and followed with back-to-back 17-yard passes to Jason Lovett and Matt Barbour to the home 24-yardline. Morgan worked his way through the Concord defense for 17 yards before following with a seven-yard scoring run over the left side to lead 35-28 with 2:05 in the game.

On 4th-and- 19 from its 41-yardline, LB Chas Johnson picked off the 4th Cavs' INT to seal the win.

DE Reggie Dorsainvil and the LB duo of Chad Hooker and Ben Robertson paced the defensive. Dorsainvil posted 11 tackles, two tfl's, 1.5 sacks and an INT. Hooker had a career-high 14 stops and Robertson added 11 tackles. Josh Spurlock and Marvin White also had Int's.

Morgan ran 110 yards on 24 carries with a TD and caught 6 passes for 56 yards including a 19-yard TD. Hippeard passed for 237 yards and 3 TDs including a 60-yd TD-strike to Aric Evans.

## Week 4

### UVA-Wise 63, Georgetown 56

WISE, Va. -- In front of a packed Carl Smith Stadium of well over 8,000 in attendance, the 10th-ranked UVA-Wise recorded its biggest Homecoming victory in program history over the 7th-ranked Georgetown College 63-56.

For the 3rd-straight contest, Ra'Shad Morgan capped the game-winning drive with a TD run as the Cavs scored last for the upset.

The win is the 1st in 8-year series and the highest ranked opponent UVA-Wise has ever defeated.

WR Jason Lovett produced his best game with 4 passes for 181 yards and 2 TDs while he threw for another TD covering 45 yards. QB Randy Hippeard hit 16 of 35 attempts for 387 yards and 3 TDs. Morgan ran for just 68 yards on 28 attempts but did score 4 TDs.

LB Ben Robertson paced the Cavs defense with 10 TT, a sack, 1.5 tfls and an INT. James Haley had 9 stops, FF and 2BK while Chas Johnson added 9 TT, SK, and a tfl. Bryan Tolbert picked off one pass and battled down 2 more to go with 6 TT while Josh Spurlock snatched his 2nd pick in 2 games. Jerry Bentley had the other Cavs' sack. Wise, Va. -- The 11th-ranked NAIA UVA-Wise football team mauled Belhaven College in every facet of the game. The Highland Cavaliers posted 710 yards of offense while the defense recorded seven sacks and five turnovers in a 69-28 victory over the Blazers.

UVA-Wise scored on 10 of its first 11 possessions and the defensive unit shut out Belhaven in the second half. The Cavs improved to 6-1 on the season and sealed its second winning season in a row for just the second time in school history. The 69 points also ties a school record set against Sue Bennett College during the 1994 season.

RB Ra'Shad Morgan had his best outing of the year. He ran for 237 yards on 28 carries and 2 TDs including a 62-yard burst in the first quarter. He also caught a pass for 31 yards. Jyron Barclay ran 14 times for 130 yards and a TD.

Jason Lovett caught 3 balls for 49 yards with 2 TDs and 2 two-point conversions as well as throwing a 47-yard end-around pass to Hakeem Abdul-Saboor for a TD. Aric Evans added 4 catches for 88 yards and a 32-yard TD.

The defense had its best outing of the season for UVA-Wise. The unit produced 7 sacks, forced 5 turnovers – 3 fumbles and 2 INTs and held the Blazers scoreless in the second half. Among the many standouts, James Haley had 10 tackles, a sack, forced a fumble, recovered another fumble and broke up 2 passes. Brett Hammack produced 7 stops, a sack and a FR. ## Week 8

### UVA-Wise 43, Pikeville 10

Wise, Va. -- The 10th-ranked UVA-Wise defense had its best outing of the year and Ra'Shad Morgan provided the punch on offense in an overpowering victory, 43-10, over rival Pikeville College.

In a season best performance, the UVA-Wise defense allowed just 195 yards with 68 of those yards coming on the Bears final drive. The defenders also produced 5 sacks, 10 tackles for loss, 3 interceptions and a forced fumble.

All-American RB Morgan totaled 284 all-purpose yards in his usual outstanding efforts. The 284 all-purpose yards gives Morgan the Cavs' career record in the category with 5,542 yards surpassing Greg Thomas (1993-96), who had 5,453. The senior rushed 24 times for 185 yards and 3 TDs while he caught 6 passes for 99 yards.

LB Ben Robertson had 9 tackles, 1.5 tfl, a sack and a forced fumble. Gio Watford posted a career-best 8 stops. DE Reggie Dorsainvil added 6 tackles, 2.5 tfl of 13 yards and 1.5 sacks. Josh Spurlock had a solo sack of 8 yards while John Mathis and Aaron Mathis and Chas Johnson each assisted on a sack.

Jamal Potter, Brandon Arrington and Danny Hinkle snatched interceptions.

WR Jason Lovett tied a single game record with 13 receptions (141 yards) and tied the season TD reception record of 11 with a 4-yard TD catch in the 1st quarter. QB Randy Hippeard completed 22 of 33 passes for 261 yards and 2 TDs. Jyron Barclay rushed 10 times for 54 yards and a 6-yard TD.

The tone was set early by the UVA-Wise defense. The unit forced two punts and allowed just 4 yards in 6 plays by Pikeville. The Cavs offense put back-to-back long drives of 10 plays for 98 yards and 12 plays for 82 yards capped by Hippeard scoring passes to Aric Evans and Lovett over 8 and 4 yards for a 14-0 score after one frame.

After leading 21-3 at the half, Lance Ayers connected on a 25-yard FG and Morgan ran in for 2 TDs to make it 37-3 at the end of the third.
