What is the National Residence Hall Honorary (NRHH)?

The NRHH is the recognition branch of NACURH. NACURH, as an organization, truly believes that recognition is a must in a strong Residence Hall community. As such, NRHH is there to make sure that we don't forget to give those needed and more than deserved pats on the back. The way NRHH works on campus is through a chapter. NRHH chapters have a very special way of recognizing those top leaders, by membership. The NRHH chapter membership (per school) is restricted to 1% of students living in the residence halls or no more than 15 active members. So, once inducted into NRHH you can consider yourself a member of the Top 1% of residence hall leaders. The NRHH national level consists of the national office. The National Office is responsible for affiliating NRHH chapters, selecting national OTM (Of the Months) and a host of other tasks.

Eligibility/Minimum Qualifications

The qualifications for induction into NRHH are: lived in residence hall at UVa-Wise for at least two (2) semesters at the time of induction; in good academic and judicial standing; and have exhibited outstanding leadership and service to the residence hall system.

Nomination Procedures from the UVa-Wise NRHH Constitution

GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF NRHH MEMBERS

The following shall be the guidelines for selection of NRHH members as provided for in ARTICLE I, Section 1 of the by-laws.

1. Nominations for NRHH shall be received during the spring and fall semesters.
2. Nominations must be submitted on the nomination forms as provided by the organization.
3. Nominations may be made by: Hall Council Members, Residence Hall Council Members, NRHH Members, Student Affairs Staff Members, Resident Directors, Resident Assistants, Students, Faculty and Staff.
4. No self-made nominations will be accepted.
5. Nominations will be accepted for two (2) weeks during the semester.
6. After receiving the nominations, the NRHH Chapter will send the nominee an application for NRHH.
7. Nominees will have exactly one (1) week after the close of nominations to return their applications.
8. The selection process will be conducted by the NRHH Chapter and the process may include interviews.
9. NRHH reserves the right to not completely fill its membership if it feels that there are not enough qualified applicants.
10. All of the new members of NRHH will be recognized during a special induction ceremony.
