



Unsung Hero Award

The University of Virginia's College at Wise

The UVa-Wise Unsung Hero Award(s) recognizes those students who have exhibited the highest standards of involvement through positive 'behind-the-scenes' and vitally important contributions to student organizations and the overall UVa-Wise student life program. This award(s) is presented at the annual Student Leadership Awards Banquet.

Eligibility

- All nominees must be a current non-executive board member in good standing of a UVa-Wise student organization.
- All nominees must have demonstrated extraordinary service and support to a student organization and the overall student life program during the current academic year.
- All nominees must be in good standing with UVa-Wise.

Who may nominate a candidate?

Any UVa-Wise student, faculty or staff member may nominate candidates. Candidates may not self-nominate.

When are nominations due?

Nomination forms are available in the Division of Student Affairs, Slemp Student Center 3rd floor Check Desk, and on-line under the *Student Leadership* link. Nominations deadline is 5 pm on Friday, March 21, 2008. Return nomination forms to the Division of Student Affairs or the Check Desk.

Who makes up the Selection Committee?

The Selection Committee is comprised of the Associate Director of the Slemp Student Center, and the president(s) or designee(s) of the following organizations: Honor Court, Interfraternity Council, Multi-Cultural Alliance, Panhellenic Council, Residence Hall Association, Student Activities Board, and the Student Government Association. Students who have been nominated may not serve on the selection committee.
