#### CHEMISTRY SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

#### ELIGIBILITY

Any entering freshman planning to major in chemistry at UVa-Wise is eligible to apply for the scholarship.

#### APPLICATION DEADLINE

The deadline for receipt of completed applications is March 15 for fall semester entry. For consideration, students must also be admitted to the College by this date.

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Students must complete the admissions process at UVa-Wise as well as complete the scholarship application on the reverse side. Students should also submit at least one letter of recommendation from a current or former science teacher.

#### SELECTION

A committee composed of two members of the chemistry faculty and a chemistry alumnus will make the final selection. The scholarship recipient must graduate in the top 20% of her/his class and score 900 or above on the SAT (Critical Reading Section and Mathematics Section), ACT, or equivalent. The essay must show a clear intent to pursue a chemistry major and convincing reasons for the choice. Financial need is not a primary factor in the selection process.

#### RENEWAL

A recipient is eligible to receive the scholarship for a total of four years. The requirements for such renewal are:

• The recipient must enroll in Chemistry 101 and Chemistry 111 during the fall semester and Chemistry 102 and Chemistry 112 during the spring semester.

• The recipient must be a declared chemistry major and making normal progress toward a chemistry degree. Normal progress is to be verified by the Chair of the Natural Science Department or the Coordinator of the chemistry program.

• The recipient must maintain at least a 2.90 G.P.A with no grade lower than a C in any course.

• The recipient must maintain full time enrollment status (at least 12 hours) at all times. Exceptions may be made in cases of illness or other extenuating circumstances.

• The recipient must be in good social standing as defined by UVa-Wise Code of Conduct.

• In cases of nonrenewal, the recipient may appeal to the Chemistry Scholarship Committee for reconsideration. The Committee's decision on renewal is final.

• Normally, recipients will be notified of renewal in June.
