In order to receive aid, you will need to provide the financial aid office with a letter from the CTE department which will indicate the classes you need to complete for your licensure. If you are working on your first teaching license, you may use Pell (in order to qualify you must have need and remaining eligibility). For student loans, you must have remaining loan eligibility and not be in default on previous student loans. You must be enrolled in at least two courses (6 hours) to use Pell or student loans.

**You may not receive aid for repeated or recertification classes.**

If your file is selected for verification, you should return the requested items to financial aid as soon as possible. Until your file is complete, your aid is tentative, will not show on your account in the business office, and cannot be processed. CTE students can monitor their financial aid on the student portal.
