Code of Conduct

As a participant in this Governor's School, your behavior and actions directly reflect on the reputation of the program and your home high school. The following community standards have been developed over the 20+ years of the program and are required of all students at all times throughout the program. Infractions against or Refusal to follow these standards could lead to your immediate dismissal from the program and notification of your infraction to your home school district.

- 1.) Students will treat all other individuals and property with respect and courtesy at all times.
- 2.) Students will participate in all Governor's School activities and only in Governor's School activities.
- 3.) Cell phones may only be kept and used only in the student's assigned dorm room during free time.
- 4.) Due to the rigorous physical activity involved daily in classes and rehearsals, students are expected to shower and follow standard oral and physical hygiene practices **DAILY**.
- 5.) No cars are allowed to be used the program participants for the duration of the program.
- 6.) No cigarettes, tobacco, alcohol, drugs or other illegal substances are allowed.
- 7.) No weapons of any kind are permitted.
- 8.) Visitors are limited to parents of the participant and are only allowed at scheduled times on the weekends.
- 9.) Females are never allowed in male dorm rooms/suites. Males are never allowed in female dorm rooms/suites.
- 10.) Students are not permitted in any other dorms on campus.
- 11.) Students will remain in their dorm suites every night between 10:30 P.M. and 7 AM except in the event of an emergency or if authorized by the Program Director or Resident Director.
- 12.) Any willful destruction of property of the University of Virginia's College at Wise will result in dismissal.

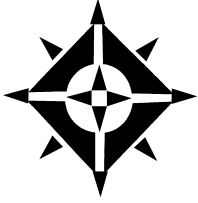

Directions to Campus

Please keep for your information



To reach UVa-Wise from most points in Virginia, you will travel on I-81 until you reach Abingdon. When you reach Abingdon, you will be about an hour from the UVA-Wise campus.

From Abingdon, VA

1. From I-81, take exit 17 - Abingdon/South Holston Dam. If you are traveling SOUTH on I-81, you will turn right into Abingdon. Those traveling NORTH should turn left. Go to the second traffic light (.7 mile). This is the main street through Abingdon. Turn left (US 11 South/US 58A West). Go to the second traffic light. Turn right onto US 58A West. (You will travel US 58A West to Norton, which is within minutes of the College).
2. Proceed to the stop sign at the intersection of US 19N/US 58A West (1 mile). Turn right. Proceed 12.2 miles north to the intersection of where US 58A and US 19 split. TURN LEFT and travel 30 miles to Norton. You will by-pass the towns of St. Paul and Coeburn.
3. As you approach Norton, you will see the Norton Inn and Super 8 motels on your left. You should be in the right lane and exit on US 23 North directly across from the Norton Inn and Super 8.
4. Proceed on the four-lane to the second traffic light (2.5 miles). You will see McDonald's on your right. Turn right here and proceed 1.2 miles into the Town of Wise on Business 23. The road will come to a traffic light at a "T" intersection. Turn right. You will see the historic Wise Inn and the Courthouse on the right as you proceed through town. Continue through town to the third traffic light (.7 mile). Turn right onto Darden Drive/Route 646 (unmarked). A Shell food market is on the corner across from you. The College is approximately .8 mile on your left.

Southwest Virginia from the North

1. Travel from your home to Pound Virginia and take US 23 heading south.
2. Proceed to the fourth traffic light for Wise. You will see McDonald's on your left. Turn left here and proceed 1.2 miles into the Town of Wise on Business 23. The road will come to a traffic light at a "T" intersection. Turn right. You will see the historic Wise Inn and the Courthouse on the right as you proceed through town. Continue through town to the third traffic light (.7 mile). Turn right onto Darden Drive/Route 646 (unmarked). A Shell food market is on the corner across from you. The College is approximately .8 mile on your left.

Southwest Virginia from the South

1. Travel from your home to US 23 and head north.
2. Proceed on US 23 to the second traffic light **PASSED** the city of Norton exits (2.5 miles from Norton). You will see McDonald's on your right. Turn right here and proceed 1.2 miles into the Town of Wise on Business 23. The road will come to a traffic light at a "T" intersection. Turn right. You will see the historic Wise Inn and the Courthouse on the right as you proceed through town. Continue through town to the third traffic light (.7 mile). Turn right onto Darden Drive/Route 646 (unmarked). A Shell food market is on the corner across from you. The College is approximately .8 mile on your left.

Entering Campus

Turn left into campus and then turn left again at the first cross street. Follow this road around campus and past a pond, a sidewalk/bridge, and a small wetlands all on your right. The next building on your right before the next drive to the right is Thomson Hall. This is where you will register for Governor's School and move into your room.

WHAT TO BRING

Please keep for your information

CLOTHES

The theater work that we will be doing requires loose, comfortable clothing that is easy to move around in, and not restrictive of movement. It should also be clothing that can get worn and dirty. Students will be doing movement-intensive activities every day as well as working in a scene and costume shops with tools and a variety of materials and paint. So, the following clothing is required for safety and function in the classroom, shop, and rehearsal process:

- Multiple pairs of Warm-up 'sweat pants' or yoga pants (loose and comfortable) – jeans, khakis, or tight pants are not allowed for classes or rehearsals
- Multiple t-shirts, a-shirts, or sweatshirts. (*Tight/form fitting, and belly-tops are not permitted in classes and rehearsals.*) Women should have sports bras or leotards for rehearsals and movement classes.
- Flat soled, closed toe shoes. (*NO FLIP-FLOPS for classes/rehearsals/shop work.*) Regular tennis-shoes are the best all purposes shoe! Rehearsals and some classes require bare feet (ballet/jazz shoes optional).
- Appropriate clothing of your choice-casual shorts, jeans, shirts, other shoes-for weekends and evenings
- Dress clothes for possible field trips or social gatherings if you want- no dress code is required.
- Rain gear for walking between classes/rehearsals
- Jacket
- Bathing suit for the campus pool/Slip & Slide events, etc.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- Pens, pencils, notebook
- Knapsack or tote bag

FOR THE DORMITORY

- Twin size sheets
- Pillow & Blanket/Sleeping bag (we may go on an overnight field trip and stay in a hotel- 4 to a room)
- Towels, washcloths, soap
- Personal items
- Fan (no Air Conditioning units allowed in Dormitory)
- Traditional Telephone (for receiving calls and for outgoing calls that are credit card or reversed charge calls) or Cell phone- Cell phones can ONLY be used in dorm rooms, not carried around by students.
- Alarm clock
- Laundry soap AND quarters for washing clothes in dormitory laundry room

FOOD

- The dormitory has a fridge and cabinetry. The RA's will have a microwave in their apartment.
- Snacks, drinks you may want in addition to the provided meals in the cafeteria.

RECREATION

- Any recreation equipment you may personally want such as ball gloves, balls, tennis rackets, Frisbees. We have access to the gymnasium, pool, and tennis courts if you are interested in participating in any of these activities.

MONEY

- Whenever and wherever we go, ***the Governor's School will pay for all food and travel.*** If you want any extras you must purchase the items yourself. Most students bring around \$50.00.

DO NOT BRING

- DO NOT BRING Televisions, Air Conditioner units, or any sort of weapon.
- DO NOT BRING Any item of substantial value- there are many outside groups on campus during the summer and if a door is accidentally left unlocked or an item is left laying around, things could go missing.
