Mr. Huguenin said state agencies have been asked to be prepared for a 7.5 percent budget cut in the next fiscal year, but that SCHEV officials seem more optimistic. State revenues are up compared to this time last year but budget projections are not being met. This is partly due to increased costs such as Medicaid, and salaries not keeping up with the cost of living.

Ms. Harris said that she is exploring the possibility of our students participating in the Blue Ridge Undergraduate Research Conference, since Emory & Henry does not wish to co-host the symposium with UVa-Wise next spring.

Ms. Harris will attend the SACSCOC annual meeting next weekend. A committee will discuss revising the principles and the QEP.
