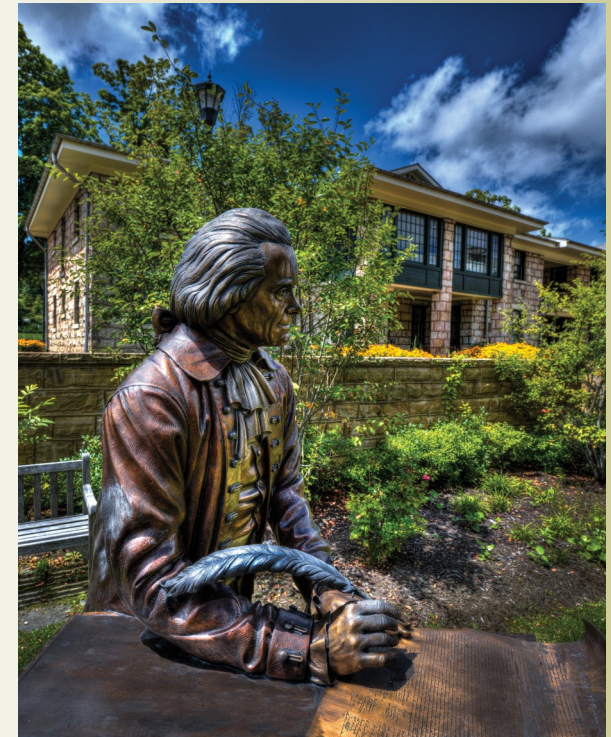

# Program Information

The Pre-Licensure Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) Program is intended to prepare students to practice as a registered nurses. Students are prepared to take the NCLEX-RN licensure exam upon graduation.

Students must complete 126 hours to earn the degree. The first and second years will enable students to complete all general education and pre-requisite courses. Third and fourth years will provide students with intensive, hands on and classroom instruction in nursing.



Application deadline is November 1. Admission decisions are made in late December. Applicants are required to take a TEAS test.
