Through an in depth exploration of the collaborative features of Google Docs, Slides, and a host of add-ons and extensions, participants will gain valuable strategies to increase student collaboration, engagement, and achievement.

- Increase their proficiency to use G Suite apps
- Use the collaborative features in G Suite apps to model best practices in collaboration in the classroom.
- Identify tools and resources to enhance their instructional delivery.
- Utilize the research features and tools in G Suite and Chrome extensions.

- Create learning activities that increase student engagement through collaboration and real world applications.
