

**UVA Board of Visitors Meeting – Notice regarding Tuition and Fees
Wednesday, November 2, 2018**

The UVA Board of Visitors will consider 2019-20 tuition, fees, room, and board for the University of Virginia's College at Wise on December 7, 2018 at 8:30 am in the Board Room of the Rotunda. This notice is provided in accordance with §23.1-307.D. of the Code of Virginia requiring 30 days notification. The University of Virginia's College at Wise's Board will also hear the College's 2019-20 tuition, fees, room, and board proposal on November 9, 2018 at 9:00am at the Oxbow Center in St. Paul, Virginia.

The College seeks to approve tuition and fees in December to provide timely information to families and earlier financial aid awards to those with financial need. Since approval will occur prior to the 2019 General Assembly session, actions by the General Assembly may influence the allocation of incremental revenue and could result in adjustments to tuition rates.

A commitment to access and affordability continues to undergird the College's approach to tuition. The College remains committed to remaining affordable to all students attending the College.

2019-20 Proposed Undergraduate Degree-seeking Tuition and Educational & General (E&G) Fees: Board members will consider a 3% increase in Tuition and E&G Fees increase undergraduate tuition and E&G fees in 2019-20:

2019-20 Proposed Mandatory Non-E&G Fees: Mandatory non-E&G fees are proposed to increase by 3.0%. This increase will address the costs of delivering student services.

2019-20 Proposed Housing and Dining Rates: Housing and dining rates are proposed to increase 3.0%.

2019-20 Incremental Revenue: Revenue generated from these tuition and fee increases, along with other incremental revenue sources, will be used to address faculty and staff compensation, investments in academic programs and STEM degrees, increases in operations and maintenance of facilities, and other Commonwealth and College priorities.
